## **Brompton-Westbrook Primary School**

## Oversubscription criteria: 2018

Following receipt of parental/carer preferences, places will be offered to those children with statements of special educational needs where Brompton-Westbrook Primary School is named. Then, if the number of requests received via the co-ordinated scheme is more than the number of places available, places will be allocated in the following priority order:

- 1. Children in public care -as defined in the Medway co-ordinated admission scheme, including previously looked children, who are now adopted
- 2. Children with a current family association (a brother or sister (including adopted, foster and step siblings) in the school at the time of application and still attending in September 2018).
- 3. Children with health reasons. Medical evidence must be provided which demonstrates a specific health reason, which requires a child to attend Brompton-Westbrook Primary School.
- 4. Multiple birth children, as defined in the Medway co-ordinated admission scheme
- 5. Children of a member of staff who has been employed at the school for two years or more
- 6. Nearness of child's home to school measured using Medway Council's criteria.

Where criteria involves measuring distance to a child's home, the Local Authority's procedures for ascertaining the shortest available safe route between home and the school will be used.

## Tie-breaker:

In the unlikely event that two or more children in all other ways have equal eligibility for the last available place at the school, the names will be issued a number and drawn randomly to decide which child should be given the place.
