Chattenden Primary School (Peninsula Gateway Academy Trust)

Oversubscription criteria: 2018

Following receipt of parental preferences, places will be offered to those children with statements of special educational needs where Chattenden Primary School (Peninsula Gateway Academy Trust) is named. Then, if the number of requests received via the co-ordinated scheme is more than the number of places available, places will be allocated in the following priority order:

- 1. Children in public care/looked after children and previously looked after children.
- 2. Sibling (a brother or sister attending the school at the time of application and who will still be attending in September 2018).
- 3. Medical, health and special access reasons.
- 4. Children of teaching staff.
- 5. Nearness of children's home and ease of access to the school. Where criteria involves measuring distance to a child's home, the LA's procedures for ascertaining the shortest available safe route between home and the school will be used.

In the unlikely event that two or more children in all other ways have equal eligibility for the last available place at the school, the names will be issued a number and drawn randomly to decide which child should be given the place.
