

Elaine Primary Academy

Oversubscription criteria: 2018

Following receipt of parental preferences, places will be offered to those children with statements of special educational needs where Elaine Primary Academy is named. Then, if the number of requests received via the co-ordinated scheme is more than the number of places available, places will be allocated in the following priority order:

1. Children in Public Care (as defined in the Medway co-ordinated admission scheme).
2. Current family association (a brother or sister in the academy at the time of application and still attending in September 2017).
3. Child's health reasons. Medical evidence must be provided which demonstrates a specific health reason which requires a child to attend Elaine Primary Academy.
4. Multiple birth children where Elaine Primary Academy is the nearest school to the child's home.
5. Nearness of children's home measured using Medway Council's criteria. Where criteria involves measuring distance to a child's home, the LA's procedures for ascertaining the shortest available safe route between home and the academy will be used.
6. In the event of a tie within any criterion, before the last criterion, places will be allocated to those living the closest distance to the academy as mentioned above.
