

Kingfisher Primary School & Children's Centre

Oversubscription criteria: 2018

Following receipt of parental/carer preferences, places will be offered to those children with statements of special educational needs where Kingfisher Primary School is named. Then, if the number of requests received via the coordinated scheme is more than the number of places available, places will be allocated in the following priority order:

1. Children in public care – as defined in the Medway coordinated admission scheme.
2. Current family association (brother or sister in the school at the time of application and still attending in September 2018).
3. Child's health reasons. Medical evidence must be provided which demonstrates a specific health reason, which requires a child to attend Kingfisher Primary School.
4. Multiple birth children, as defined in the Medway coordinated admission scheme.
5. Nearness of child's home to school measured using Medway Council's criteria. In the event of a tie within any criterion before the last, places will be allocated to those living the closest distance to the school as mentioned above.
6. Where criteria involves measuring distance to a child's home, the Local Authority's procedures for ascertaining the shortest available safe route between home and the school will be used.
