Stoke Community School

Oversubscription criteria: 2018

Following receipt of parental preferences, places will be offered to those children with statements of special educational needs where Stoke Community School is named. Then, if the number of requests received via the co-ordinated scheme is more than the number of places available, places will be allocated in the following priority order:-

- 1. Children in Public Care (as defined in the Medway co-ordinated admission scheme)
- 2. Child's health reasons. Medical evidence must be provided which demonstrates a specific health reason which requires a child to attend Stoke Community School.
- 3. Current family association (a brother or sister in the school at the time of application and still attending in September 2018).
- 4. Multiple birth children where Stoke Community School is the nearest school to the child's home.
- 5. Nearness of children's home measured using Medway Council's criteria.

Where criteria involves measuring distance to a child's home, the LA's procedures for ascertaining the shortest available safe route between home and the school will be used.

In the event of a tie within any criterion, before the last criterion, places will be allocated to those living the closest distance to the school as mentioned above.
