Oversubscription criteria: 2018

Following receipt of parental/carer preferences, places will be offered to those children with statements of special educational needs where Twydall Primary School is named. Then, if the number of requests received via the coordinated scheme is more than the number of places available, places will be allocated in the following priority order:

- 1. Children in public care -as defined in the Medway co-ordinated admission scheme, including previously looked after children, who are now adopted
- 2. Children with a current family association (a brother or sister, including adopted, foster and step siblings living in the same house) in the school at the time of application and still attending in September 2018).
- 3. Children with health, medical and special access reasons. Medical evidence must be provided which demonstrates a specific health reason, which requires a child to attend Twydall Primary School.
- 4. Children of teaching staff at Twydall Primary School
- 5. Multiple birth children, as defined in the Medway co-ordinated admission scheme
- 6. Nearness of child's home to school measured using Medway Council's criteria. Where criteria involve measuring distance to a child's home, the Local Authority's procedures for ascertaining the shortest available safe route between home and the school will be used.

Tie-breaker:

In the unlikely event that two or more children in all other ways have equal eligibility for the last available place at the school, the names will be issued a number and drawn randomly to decide which child should be given the place.
